-Launch fees are waived for tournament boats on tournament days.

- May stagger weigh-in times by one half hour dependent on the number of boats. Determined 30 days before tournament starts.

Fish Limits

Fish size: 14" and over. Any fish brought in that is under 14" is a state violation and will result in DQ for the tournament.

Teams are allowed to weigh a limit of 5 fish per team per day.

Culling is legal with a limit of 10 fish in the livewell.

No more than **two rods** per person.

Live wells must be empty at time of inspection (bait wells not included).
